To ensure that all guests have a safe and enjoyable visit to Ford Field, guests are not permitted to bring the following items into the stadium: Alcoholic beverages or beverages in any type container, any hard objects, noise makers of any kind, any large bags (Only NFL and Ford Field Approved), balloons, balls, carriers (with lens longer than 5 inches) cans, fireworks, food, guns, weapons, laser devices, strollers, umbrellas, or weapons. The following items will be permitted after inspection: small bags (maximum size 8 1/2" x 14" x 10"), diaper bags (only if accompanied by a child, binoculars (and case), small cameras (5 inch lens limit), small radios, small compact umbrellas, and school/league approved posters/signs without poles or sticks.
