Also at our November 12 meeting we collected 26 sweatshirts and \$170 in money which will be given to **Holy Cross Services.** The money will be used to create Bath Baskets. I received notification that the Detroit Diocese Knights have collected \$40,000 for an **Ultrasound Machine**. With the match from the Supreme Council we will be able to purchase 2 machines. Money was collected over two years and we

donated \$500 each year or a total of \$1,000. We should all be proud of that accomplishment. The **Special Olympics Halloween Dance** was once again well received. Special thanks to Chairman Bob Rugenski. We had 80 athletes and about 50 others in attendance. We received a very nice thank you card from the Mog family. The **Pancake Breakfast for the Food Pantry** raised \$390. **The Golf Fundraiser** was a huge success, especially for our first time. We raised \$1,376.25 for Alpha. Special thanks to Co-Chairs Robert Johnson and Randy Martin. Our Tootsie Roll Drive for the Intellectually Disabled raised \$2,700. Special thanks to Co-Chairs Larry Redman and Joe Pryce. The Officers have suggested the funds be split 3 ways, with the Special Olympic Plymouth Canton Stars, the St. Louis Center, and St. Francis Camp on the Lake. They all support the Intellectually Disabled and are supported by the Knights of Columbus. We will vote on this at our next membership meeting on December 10. As previously mentioned in an email, we recruited 24 men to the Knights as a result of our **Membership Drive**. Special thanks to Larry Redman. There is a Major Degree scheduled in Garden City on December 8.
