Marshall chaired the trip this month to Forgotten Harvest where he worked in the morning with the group from SJN and worked the afternoon shift with the Knights and their families packaging food products for local charities to be distributed to needy families.

The family attends Mass weekly, are regular attendees of the family ministry and the family has participated in the Special Olympics Halloween Dance. Our **Pancake Breakfast** held on February 1 raised \$1,181 in donations towards our seminarian Nick Brown. At our membership meeting we approved increasing the donation t \$1,500 to brother Knight and seminarian Nick Brown.

This weekend is the final weekend to collect returned bottles with donations for the **Baby Bottle Boomerang** for Family Life Services. Last year we collected over \$3200. We gave out more bottles this year than last year, so we expect the final count will be higher. Thank you to all the Knights who helped out and to Chip Ostermeyer and Marshall for helping lead this event.
